Rebecca is dedicated to the world around her and her personal success. She hopes to eventually attend UCLA and study law.

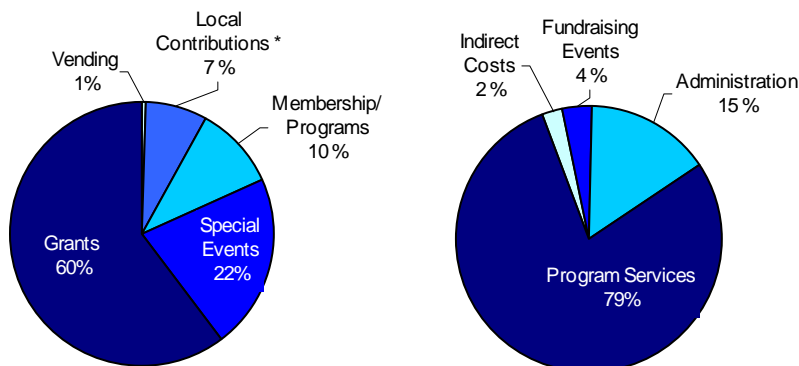
