## Chairman's Message - Steve Wagner



As the 2009-2010 fiscal year comes to a close, we are buoyed by a sense of optimism. I am proud to say that the Boys & Girls Club of San Marcos has kept focused on its mission and pressed forward to provide hope and opportunity to our youth even in the challenging economic conditions faced by our community, state and country. We have worked diligently for every penny raised and have been frugal with our expenditures while proving high quality programs in a safe and enriching environment. The programs and experiences we offer to our youth are the stepping stones that inspire and enable them to reach their full potential to be productive, responsible and caring citizens.

This is perhaps the most important time to keep our doors open, especially to those that need us most. We are proud to have reached a membership of nearly 3,000 youth this past year, while the daily average attendance during the school year was over 700.

We have many program highlights this past year, including sending 10 teen members to the Keystone Leadership Conference in San Francisco, providing 12 families with presents, Christmas trees and joy during the holiday season, and conducting a "Day For Kids" carnival event for over 500 kids and families. In addition, our fun and life-enhancing programs included technology, fine arts, performing arts, career exploration, healthy life-styles, character & leadership development, financial literacy and sports and recreation.

Perhaps our greatest success this past year was when our teen member, Kelly Martinez, was named 2010 San Diego County Youth of the Year. She went on to represent the county in the California State finals in Sacramento. Kelly was awarded over \$3,000 in college scholarships from Boys & Girls Clubs of America. We are proud of her achievements and wish her well as she attends the University of California, Davis in the fall.

The majority of our fundraising endeavors exceeded our expectations. We were blessed to be supported by the San Marcos community...individuals and businesses alike. We embarked on a new "Pancake Breakfast of Champions" fundraiser this year in partnership with the Deputies of the San Marcos Sheriff's Station. We sold the tickets and they flipped the jacks. We sold over 500 tickets, and we are ready to do it again next year!

It has been my pleasure to serve as the Chairman of the Board. The dedication of the staff, my fellow Board Members, the Associates For Youth Members, sponsors, committee members, and program volunteers is amazing. I have chosen to be involved in this organization because of its tangible, positive impact on the youth of our community, the future leaders of our nation. I look forward to many more years supporting the Boys & Girls Club of San Marcos.

## San Diego County Youth of the Year



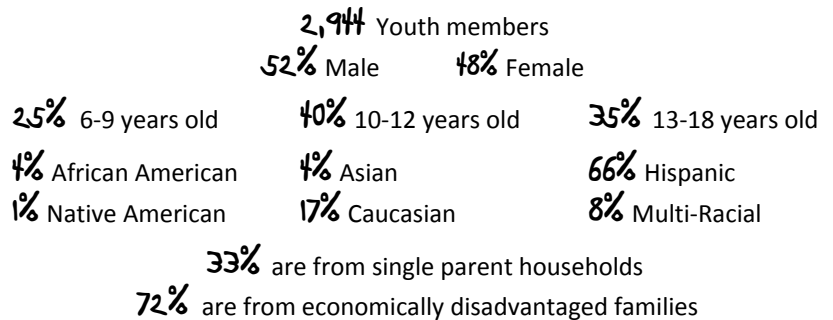

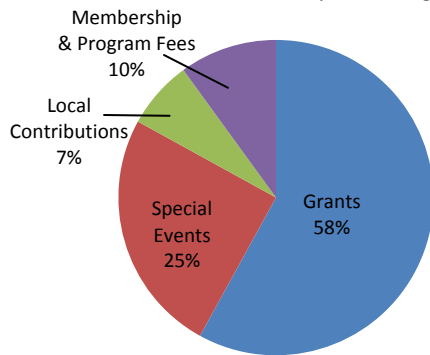

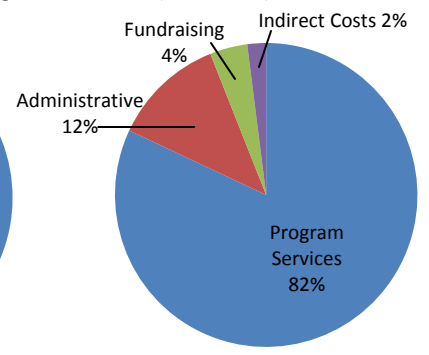


## Operational Finances
