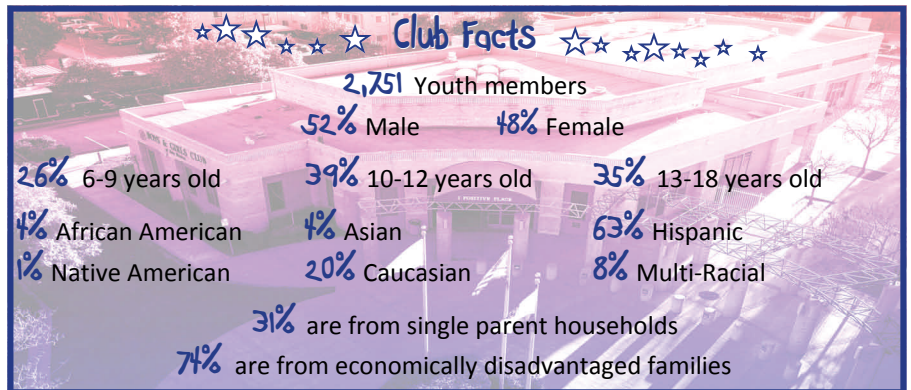

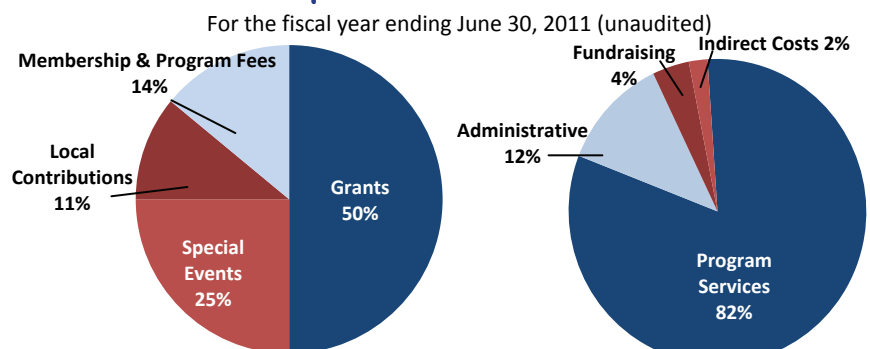

Chelsea claims, "The staff taught me so many things my mom never had. They taught me right from wrong and social skills. They also taught me academic skills, like how to write essays, solve math equations, and how to debate. They taught me what a role model looks like; they are friendly, intelligent, funny, and understanding." Chelsea has a great future ahead of her. She aspires to be a Club staff, while attending college to earn a nursing degree. She is an amazing young woman who will continue to impact her community.
